Responding patrol units set up a perimeter and with the aid of a Gurnee PD Canine unit, performed a search of a nearby construction area, the Metra tracks and bike path areas. No suspect or weapon was recovered at this time. The caller received treatment at Lake Forest Hospital for a minor cut to the hand that occurred during the incident but was not transported by first responders.</p> <p>On Monday November 19th around 1:45 am, Lake Forest Police took into custody a male juvenile, age 16, who were positively identified as the offender in Friday's attempted armed robbery in Lake Forest. Lake Forest Police originally identified the Lake Forest resident as a person of interest through investigative leads uncovered late Friday night and Saturday.
