WHAT IS CROYA?

Established 30 years ago, CROYA (Committee Representing Our Young Adults) is a safe, fun, free, nonsectarian, and inclusive youth agency open to all 7th—12th graders in Lake Forest, Lake Bluff & Knollwood. CROYA offers more than 300 programs to 2,000-plus teens annually. CROYA is unique in that it is run by young adults, for young adults, with trusted staff always present.

WHAT ARE CROYA'S PROGRAMS?

Weekly youth meetings (check the CROYA web site and calendar), leadership programs, community service projects, social programs, and support programs.

DO YOUTH HAVE TO JOIN OR PAY DUES TO BE A PART OF CROYA?

No! All 7th – 12th graders living in Lake Forest, Lake Bluff, and Knollwood can attend CROYA meetings and programs. There are sometimes additional fees for special programs and field trips.

Northern Suburban Special Recreation Association

The Northern Suburban Special Recreation Association (NSSRA) is an intergovernmental partnership of ten park districts and two cities, including Lake Forest. The Association provides year-round recreation and leisure opportunities for children, teens, adults and seniors with disabilities. Individuals with physical, cognitive, emotional, social, or other disabilities residing in the northern suburbs are eligible to participate.

NSSRA recognizes that some people with disabilities prefer to attend Recreation Department programs and in that case, NSSRA can help residents with Inclusion and Cooperative Program services. NSSRA provides Lake Forest Parks & Recreation Department staff with training, guidance, help with modifications of rules and other areas of adaptation. When deemed necessary, the Association can provide extra staff, sign language interpreters, behavior management support, disability awareness, mobility training and other adaptive assistance.
