Summary	Police responded to the area of Spruce and Sheridan after receiving a 911 call concerning a person who appeared to be passed out in the driver seat of a black SUV. Police located a black Ford Escape that was running near the Cemetery located at 500 Spruce and it was occupied by a male driver later identified as Kull. Officers observed Kull to be slumped over and he appeared to be breathing. Officers knocked on the vehicles window and were able to wake Kull up. When officers were able to speak to Kull they smelled the odor of alcohol coming from Kull as well as the odor of cannabis coming from the vehicle. During the subsequent interview Kull was demonstrating obvious signs of impairment leading officers to request he submit to some standard field sobriety test. Officers also located controlled substances in his possession. Kull was arrested for Driving Under the Influence and possession of controlled substances. Kull's vehicle was searched and other drugs plus paraphernalia were located in the vehicle. Kull was transported to Lake Forest Hospital for chemical testing. Kull was then taken to the Lake Forest PD where he was processed, charges were approved by the Lake County State's attorney and Kull was held pending transport to bond court.
