Summary	<p>Police on routine patrol responded to a reported crash involving two vehicles at Rte. 41 and Deerpath. Officers located the crash and spoke to the two drivers involved. Officers were able to determine that Udoh was operating a Honda Accord when he rear-ended a Jeep Cherokee. Officers observed that Udoh was demonstrating signs of impairment and when officers checked his driving history, they found Udoh had been arrested in March 2020 by Lake Forest Police for DUI-drugs. Officers requested Udoh complete some standard field sobriety tests to determine his ability to drive; Udoh complied with the testing. Officers observed various small baggies on the passenger seat of Udoh's Honda with a white substance inside. Police located a glass pipe with burnt residue in Udoh's pants pocket as well as eight individual small baggies of a white powder/rock substance which would later field test positive for cocaine. Based on his performance on the test, his driving, and the officer's observations, Udoh was arrested and charged with Failure to Reduce Speed, DUI-drugs, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Possession of Controlled Substance while operating a motor vehicle. Lake County States Attorney approved a class 4 felony charge for possession of a controlled substance. Udoh was held over pending transport to the Lake County Jail for a bond hearing.</p>

Summary	<p>Police on routine patrol in the area of Green Bay Road and Old Elm Road observed a white 2014 Audi SUV which had minor front and driver side damage, along with both driver side tires flat and riding on the rim, as it drove north on Green Bay Road from Old Elm Road. When officers conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle, they spoke to the driver, who was identified as Roti. While officers were speaking with Roti, they noted he appeared to be confused, have bloodshot, glassy eyes, and slurred speech. Roti was requested to complete some standard field sobriety tests to determine his ability to drive. Based on Roti's ability to complete the SFSTs, the officer's observations of his condition and his vehicle, and Roti's statement that he was driving too fast on the off-ramp, crashed his vehicle, and was driving on two rims, Roti was placed under arrest. He was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Roti was transported to the Public Safety Building, where he was processed, released on bond, and given a mandatory court date in June.</p>

Summary	Police responded to the area of Rte. 41 and Rte. 60 on a reported multi-vehicle crash in that area. Police determined that the vehicle driven by Space was at fault in the crash, and, while investigating the incident, officers determined that Space was displaying signs of alcohol impairment. Space admitted to drinking alcohol prior to the crash. Space was requested to complete some standard field sobriety tests to determine his ability to drive. Summary	Police responded to the intersection of Rte. 41 and Old Elm Road on a reported single vehicle crash. Police were informed that a blue Volkswagen had struck the center median and the driver was passed out behind the wheel. Officers located the crash and found the unresponsive driver, Faught, in the driver's seat. Officers were able to wake Faught up and when dealing with him they located a half-empty 1.75l vodka bottle between the driver's seat and the driver's door. Faught admitted to drinking beer and mixed drinks prior to driving and officers could smell the odor of alcohol coming from his breath. Faught was assessed by Lake Forest Fire personnel at the scene and subsequently transported to Northwestern Lake Forest ER for evaluation and treatment. Faught was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and was requested to submit to chemical bold and urine testing, which he refused. Faught was eventually processed, released on bond, and given a June court date.

Summary	<p>Police responded to the area of Waukegan Road after receiving a 911 call concerning a suspected impaired driver who was swerving all over the road. The 911 caller stated the suspected green Jeep was missing a bumper and was driving on a flat rear tire. Police located the vehicle on Waukegan Road and conducted a traffic stop. Officers spoke to the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle, identified as Garcia. They determined he was demonstrating signs of impairment, he had an odor of alcohol coming from him, and he was unable to correctly answer several questions. Police noted that his vehicle, in addition to the missing bumper and driving on a flat tire, was also covered in mud on one side and the windshield was cracked. Using a translator, officers were able to determine Garcia drank several beers prior to driving. Garcia submitted to standard field sobriety tests and was subsequently placed under arrest, transported to the Public Safety Building for processing, and released on bond with a May court date.</p>
