<b>Subject(s)</b>	Leitschuh, Jennifer, female, age 40, 1111 S. Waukegan Road, Lake Forest IL 60045			
<b>Summary</b>	<p>Police responded to the 1100 block of Acorn Trail for a woman sleeping in a vehicle with a baby in the back seat. Police located the vehicle and observed the vehicle slowly rolling down the road with the female driver slumped over the wheel. Police were able to get the car stopped and have a conversation with the driver, who was identified as Jennifer Leitschuh. When officers requested Leitschuh provide them with her driver's license, the officers noted she appeared disoriented, had bloodshot and watery eyes, her speech was slurred, and she was demonstrating signs of drug impairment. Officers requested Leitschuh perform some standard field sobriety tests to determine her ability to drive. Based on Leitschuh sleeping at the wheel, self-admittance to being on medication, and displayed-signs of impairment while submitting to SFST, Leitschuh was placed under arrest for driving under the influence of drugs. Police contacted a family member to take custody of the baby and Leitschuh was transported to Lake Forest Hospital for a drug test. Leitschuh was transported to the Public Safety Building where she was issued citations for Driving Under the Influence-Drugs and Child Endangerment, processed, and released on bond with a mandatory October court date. Police also contacted DCFS regarding the child endangerment.</p>

<b>Summary</b>	<p>Lake Forest Police responded to a reported single vehicle accident in the 100 block of South Green Bay Road near Onwentsia Road. Police located a 1999 Jeep with significant damage and four flat tires at the scene. Police located Diaz at the scene, and identified him as the driver and the sole occupant of the Jeep when it crashed. Officers noted that Diaz had a strong odor of alcohol on his breath and made several statements about being intoxicated. After conducting the crash and Driving Under the Influence of investigation, Diaz was arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and transported to the Public Safety Building for processing. Diaz was released on bond and given a mandatory court date in September.</p>

<b>Subject(s)</b>	Bernardi, Christopher A, male, age 34, 130 Niles Ave., Lake Forest IL 60045			
<b>Summary</b>	Lake Forest Police responded to a 911 call concerning an older model Jeep that was "all over the road" on Rte. 41. Officers located the vehicle and, after observing several moving violations, conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle. Officers spoke with the driver, identified as Bernardi, and during the interview, the officer determined that Bernardi was demonstrating signs of impairment. The officer requested Bernardi complete some field sobriety tests to determine his ability to drive. Based on the observations by the officer, Bernardi was arrested for Driving Under the Influence-Drugs. Officers located baggies in Bernardi's wallet that contained a white powder that tested positive for heroin. Bernardi was transported to Northwestern Lake Forest Hospital for a drug test, which he refused. Bernardi was processed and held on the felony drug possession until a bond hearing.

<b>Summary</b>	Police conducted a traffic stop on a black Land Rover after observing the vehicle fail to stop at a stop sign and drive in the wrong lane on the road. When the officer approached the vehicle and spoke to the driver, identified as Munoz, the officer could smell the odor of alcohol coming from Munoz's breath. As they conversed, the officer observed that Munoz was demonstrating signs of alcohol impairment. The officer requested Munoz complete some standard field sobriety tests to determine his ability to drive. Based on Munoz's driving, a strong odor of alcohol beverage on his breath, his demonstrated signs of impairment, and his performance during SFST, Munoz he was placed under arrest for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Munoz was transported to the Public Safety Building for processing and released on bond with a mandatory September court date.

<b>Summary</b>	Raymond Lawn Services employees reported their red Chevrolet 3500 pickup truck and Wells Cargo trailer, with landscape equipment inside, was stolen while parked at a job site on Burton Dr. Lake Forest Police issued a local look out for the vehicle and Highland Park police spotted the vehicle driving south on Rte. 41 exiting at Clavey. <b>Summary</b>	Police responded to a traffic complaint on Rte. 41 concerning a white Dodge pickup driving north that was a possible DUI. Police conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle after observing some hazardous driving by the driver of the pickup. Officers spoke to the driver, identified as Finucane, who was the sole occupant in the vehicle. The officer observed Finucane's speech to be slurred with a strong odor of alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath, and he was demonstrating other signs of alcohol impairment. The officer asked Finucane if he was drinking prior to driving and Finucane stated he went to a bar after work, was there for an hour, and consumed three (3) beers. Officers requested Finucane complete some standard field sobriety tests. Based on the officer's observation of Finucane's driving, his physical condition, and his ability to complete the field sobriety test, Finucane was placed under arrest and charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Finucane was transported to the Public Safety Building where he was processed and submitted to chemical breath testing which resulted in a reading of 0.181 BAC. Finucane subsequently admitted to drinking 6-10 beers while at the bar prior to driving. Finucane was released on bond and given an August court date.

<b>Summary</b>	Police were dispatched to a traffic crash at Rte. 41 and Rte. 60. Police located the crash and observed a white Honda had driven off the roadway approximately 50 ft. into a grass field. That driver was identified as Gutierrez, Javier. Police conducted a traffic crash investigation and while discussing the details of the crash with Gutierrez, officers could smell the odor of alcohol coming from his breath and he was demonstrating visible signs of impairment.
