Summary	Police investigated a reported residential burglary and theft at Lake Forest College that was reported February 10, 2020. An unknown male offender was suspected of entering a dorm on Lake Forest College and then entered several dorm rooms for the purpose of committing thefts. Victims reported the theft of several items including currency exceeding \$500 and an Apple MacBook computer. Video of the suspect was obtained and after posting the photos on social media Lake Forest detectives developed Harold Wilbourn as a suspect. Police worked on obtaining a positive ID of Wilbourn and determining if he was the suspect who committed the burglary and theft. Wilbourn had prior arrest for theft of Apple Mac Books from a Google Store as well as arrest for Burglary and Theft over \$500. Wilbourn is currently on parole. Following investigative efforts by Lake Forest Detectives, an arrest warrant was obtained for Wilbourn on March 10, 2020. On March 25, the Lake County Sheriff's Warrant Unit located Wilbourn, took him into custody, and transported him to the Lake County Jail for a bond hearing.

Summary	Lake Forest Police responded to a report of a vehicle traveling southbound on Sheridan Rd, in the northbound lanes. Dispatch advised that a Great Lakes Police Department Officer was behind a vehicle on Sheridan, in the wrong lane of traffic. Lake Bluff Police advised over the radio that they had located the vehicle and observed it driving in the wrong lane of Sheridan Rd. Police following the suspect vehicle had their lights and sirens working in an effort to stop the vehicle before it caused an accident. The vehicle continued into Lake Forest and after refusing to stop for police and driving around the central business district in an unsafe manner, the suspect turned onto Scott Street and into the driveway at 333 Scott Street. Udoh was taken into custody without incident and officers immediately suspect he was under the influence of narcotics due to his behavior and physical condition. Udoh was transported to Lake Forest Hospital for evaluation and a DUI-drug test. After conducting further investigation into Udoh's actions, he was charged with Driving Under the Influence-Drugs, Fleeing & Eluding Police, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Udoh was released on bond and given a May court date.

Summary	Police responded to a 911 call concerning a two-vehicle crash at Rte. 41 and Westleigh Road. Police located a black Audi with front-end damage (driven by Chib) and a gray Toyota Camry with rear end damage driven by the victim. When officers interviewed Chib about the crash, officers were able to smell the odor of alcohol on his breath, he demonstrated signs of impairment, and, when asked, he admitted to drinking wine before driving. As part of the investigation, Chib was requested to complete some field sobriety tests to determine his ability to drive. Based on the officer's observations, Chib's driving, and his performance on the field sobriety test, Chib was arrested and charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Chib was transported to the Public Safety Building where he was processed, submitted to chemical breath testing with a result of 0.147 BAC, and released on bond. Chib has a mandatory April court date.
