A vehicle search was conducted and officers located several bags of cannabis, a small supply of cannabis edibles that were packaged for re-sale, several vape pen cartridges containing THC, several substances that tested positive for Heroin, and several other pieces and packages containing cannabis and THC. Yesenia admitted to making and selling the Cannabis edibles through online resources and police located \$3,015.00 in cash wrapped up in separate cash bundles. Yesenia was processed, charged with Illegal Possession of Controlled Substances: 15-100g Morphine, Possession of Cannabis 100-500g & Delivery/Manufacture Cannabis 30-500g. She was held pending transport to the Lake County Jail for a bond hearing.
