Summary	An officer on routine patrol observed the driver of a silver Nissan Pathfinder commit several driving infractions. The officer conducted a traffic stop on the Nissan and spoke with the driver, Martinez-Sanchez, concerning his driving. Officers observed that Martinez-Sanchez was demonstrating signs of alcohol impairment and Martinez-Sanchez admitted to drinking six (6) beers prior to driving. Officers requested Martinez-Sanchez complete some standard field sobriety tests to determine his ability to drive. Due to Martinez-Sanchez's extremely poor driving, signs of impairment, his poor performance on SFSTs, and his admission to drinking alcohol approximately 30 minutes prior to the stop, Martinez-Sanchez was placed under arrest for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Martinez-Sanchez was transported to the Public Safety Building where he was processed and released on bond with a mandatory December court date.

Summary	Police observed a blue Toyota Scion speeding on Western Avenue and failing to stop at a stop sign at Westminster and McKinley. Police conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle after it turned into a dead end parking lot. Officers identified the driver as Crump, and after running the license plate, they determined the vehicle was stolen out of Chicago and that Crump had an active Failure to Appear warrant on a Probation Violation. Crump was placed under arrest and transported to the Public Safety Building for further investigation. Police consulted with the Lake County States Attorney and a charge of Possession of a Stolen Vehicle was approved. Crump was transported to the Lake County jail and held on a \$30,000 bond.

Summary	Police conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for a traffic violation in the area of Sheridan Road and College after observing the vehicle driving erratically on Mayflower Road. Police spoke to the driver, Montoya, concerning the stop. Montoya acted suspicious and, when asked about the odor of alcohol on his breath the officer could smell, Montoya admitted to drinking a few beers prior to driving. While talking to Montoya, officers observed a 32 oz. beer can shoved under the front seat. Montoya was requested to exit the car and complete some field sobriety tests. Based on the officer's observations and Montoya's performance on the field sobriety test, he was placed under arrest and charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Montoya was transported to the Public Safety Building where he was processed, submitted to chemical breath testing with a result of 0.90 BAC, and was released on bond with a mandatory November court date.
